Rose-breasted Grosbeak



Look out for these frequent feeder visitors to be feeding on the sunflower seeds, peanuts and safflower seeds in your Lyric Supreme-filled feeder. You can also listen for their highly adorned song, similar to that of a Robin, or their high-pitched call, a sharp "chink!" that sounds much like a sneaker squeaking on a gym floor. These birds are even known to sing while they sit on their nest, an action that is very rare among bird species. Though they are a commoner of backyards and suburban areas, Rose-breasted Grosbeaks can also be found in woodlands and forest edges.

Eastern Towhee

A bird that you're probably more likely to find hopping on the ground than flying in the sky, the Eastern Towhee makes its home among scrubby, brushy areas. If you have this sort of vegetation in your backyard, listen for some rustling and you might just find an Eastern Towhee living there. Even if they aren't living in your backyard, a tray feeder filled with Lyric Supreme is likely to be a popular dining spot for Eastern Towhees, as this mix features three of their favorite bites: black oil sunflower seeds, millet, and cracked corn.





Blue Jay

Blue Jays are common feeder birds found throughout the United States. These steady flying birds typically live around oak trees, both on the edges of the forest and in suburban areas, as they are big fans of the acorns that these trees produce. Their light blue plumage, prominent crests, and distinct, noisy calls make them a familiar sight and sound to many backyards across the country. While they love to visit feeders with peanuts and sunflower seeds, you can also attract Blue Jays to your backyard with a bird bath.

American Goldfinch

The American Goldfinch is a favorite feeder sight all across the United States, even garnering the title of state bird in Washington, Iowa, and New Jersey. These bright yellow birds love to snack on the Nyjer and Sunflower seeds found in Lyric Supreme, and they will bring their flock to almost any feeder that features these seeds. While they are adored for their bright yellow bodies, American Goldfinches are the only birds in the finch family to molt their feathers twice a year, replacing all of their feathers in late summer for a drab, brown-black look, and most of their body feathers in late spring, as they return to their signature yellow-bodied look.
