Here is a little bit about a few of the feathered friends that you might find feeding on Lyric Fine Tunes at your feeder:



Eastern Bluebird

Eastern Bluebirds primarily feed on insects, but they will visit a feeder for finely chopped seeds and nuts like those in Lyric Fine Tunes. You can find these birds flying in open meadows and fields, perching on wires and fences, or in your own backyard, as they are frequent backyard visitors. Breeding pairs of Eastern Bluebirds frequently use nest boxes to house their brood, so you can also attract these birds to your yard by setting up a nest box.

Red-bellied Woodpecker

The Red-bellied Woodpecker, not to be confused with the rarer Red-headed Woodpecker, is most commonly found in forestry areas, foraging around the bark of a tree. You can attract these rosy tummied birds to your backyard by hanging a Lyric Fine Tunes-filled feeder from a tree branch or near the trunk of a tree. Watch for the Red-bellied Woodpecker to take the food they find in your feeder and store it for later in the cracks and crevices of surrounding trees. And, with the small bite-sized pieces of Lyric Fine Tunes, you may even catch them feeding their young at your feeder.



House Finch

The House Finch is commonly mistaken for another finch family member known as the Purple Finch. You can distinguish between these two birds as the House Finch is a reddish-orange, while the Purple Finch is a reddish-purple. A common sight at backyard feeders, the House Finch can be found in neighborhoods and urban areas all across the country. If a House Finch chooses to snack at your feeder, look out, it may just bring the rest of its flock for a meal - that can mean as many as 50 or more birds!

Northern Cardinal

You can't miss the striking red color or loud whistle of a Northern Cardinal at your feeder. Even in the winter, these birds stand out as their bright plumage doesn't fade like many other bird species. Though they are quite shy, Northern Cardinals will visit almost any feeder, especially those filled with Lyric Fine Tunes, as it includes a Northern Cardinal favorite: sunflower kernels. When they aren't feeding in your backyard, look for these sharp red birds in dense thickets, woodlands and gardens.
